Erica is a graduate of UNBC with a Bachelor of Education and is currently teaching in Haida Gwaii.

James Reid was born to Michael and Yvonne Reid of Terrace, British Columbia. James' father is a retired educator who is a son of a British home child and a Blackfoot orphan. James' mother is the child of an Eastern European refugee who fled Europe during World War II. James is a proud father of five. With degrees in history and education he graduated from UBC and took his first teaching position in Masset, Haida Gwaii. He has been teaching in Haida Gwaii for sixteen years.
